Grades K-1 and Grades 2-3 Indoor Soccer Instructional League

Location: Clarkston Community Education Center/Sashabaw Middle School

Kindergarten and 1st Grade Indoor Soccer League

This indoor soccer league will give kindergarten and 1st grade boys and girls the chance to play an organized indoor soccer game each week with experienced coaches. Director Alex Eve will oversee all games throughout the season. No prior experience is required for participation. Games will be Saturday mornings at 9am, and 10am.

2nd and 3rd Grade Indoor Soccer League

This is an expansion of the very popular Saturday morning kindergarten and 1st grade Future Star Soccer indoor instructional league. 2nd and 3rd graders can now play indoor soccer games each Saturday under the direction of coach Alex Eve. Games will be Saturday afternoons at 11am, and 12 pm.

Both K-1 and 2-3 grades are set up as follows: The first meeting of seven will be used as an evaluation/fun soccer session with the intention of dividing up the registered children onto equal teams of 12. Skill development, not winning will be stressed. Schedules will be done after the evaluation then placed on the web site (www.futurestarsports.com) for easy access, giving all families the six-game season schedule. PLEASE REGISTER EARLY: The decision to run a class must be made on the basis of enrollment numbers one week before the camp is scheduled to begin. Also, many classes fill up within one or two days of the beginning of registration. Avoid disappointment, register early.

REFUND POLICY: We reserve the right to cancel a camp if the minimum enrollment cannot be met. Money will be fully refunded. In the event enrollment exceeds the maximum, you will be notified and your money refunded. When dropping a camp refunds must be requested prior to the second camp meeting. A \$10 service fee will be charged. Refunds on 1-day classes must be requested 5 days prior to the class date. A \$25 fee for all non-sufficient fund checks will be charged.
