

Troy Parks & Recreation presents 2nd Annual 2010 Spring Outdoor Soccer League



Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd Grade Boys and Girls

Location: Troy & Athens High School turf field

This instructional league will have one coach on the field, coaching both teams concurrently. Two assistant coaches will be on the sidelines helping the children with equipment, positions, and substitutions. Our goals for the season include: field positioning, ball control, player-to-player communication, and vision/awareness of teammates on the field. Children entering this league will be instructed the moment they set foot on the field, those on the side lines waiting will be encouraged to watch their teammates play.

We welcome parents to watch and cheer on their children although prohibit sideline coaching. Children's development and attitude improve much greater when receiving instruction directly from their head coach during games. Therefore, we ask that all parents and fans refrain from yelling 'kick it' and other 'coaching' phrases from the sidelines.

Teams will be assigned according to requests submitted by their parents. It is our intention to build teams of 13 players. Teams will be gender divided and put together on a first submitted, first placed basis. Once the roster maximum is reached, no additional players will be added. Jerseys will be distributed to all players.

The first week of play will be used as a ball control practice, ice breaker and an opportunity for the children and parents to meet the coaches. On the first day, all parents will be given instructions for getting children placed together on teams and accessing the seasons game times. Getting friends together on the same team is our first priority. Games will be played weeks two through six. Games times will fluctuate between 10am and 1pm start times. Winning or losing will not be part of the league, nor will standings or league ending play-offs. All children will receive a participation metal after the last scheduled game.

Cost: \$69 per player (includes team jerseys).

Games: 10am, 11am, 12pm, and/or 1pm. One one-hour game per week. No weekday commitments.

Divisions: New in 2010, there will be two ability divisions offered. All kindergarten children will be required to join our division 1 program (reg. Code: 124055A) and all 2nd graders will be required to join our division 2 program (reg. Code: 124055B). All 1st grade children have a choice based on personal preference and experience/athleticism. Please indicate league choice on the registration application.
